

ADVANCED DEBRIEFING SKILLS

Overview

This course addresses a range of skills relevant to the design, delivery and debriefing of immersive simulation in healthcare. This includes scenario design and delivery, application to different settings (for example in –situ and laboratory), program design and delivery issues and debriefing to promote reflective learning.

Target Audience

This course is relevant to health professional educators who teach with simulation methods.

Level

Advanced

Prerequisite: Completion of a simulation instructor program or certificate in simulation and substantial debriefing practice.

Aims

To develop advanced skills relevant to learning and feedback — whether these are used in the setting of simulated learning (debriefing), clinical supervision or ward-based learning. The course focusses on debriefing and feedback conversations with individuals and groups

Topics covered

The course focuses on the following topics

- · Advanced questioning techniques
- · Co-debriefing
- · Dealing with challenging situations and learners
- · Balancing learner centredness with curriculum requirements
- · Peer feedback and faculty development

Approach

Participants will work in small groups with experienced clinical simulation instructors engaging in discussion, role play, simulations with actors and feedback from instructors.

Prerequisites

Completion of a simulation instructor program or certificate in simulation and substantial debriefing practice.

Maximum Participants

Maximum of 12 participants per course
